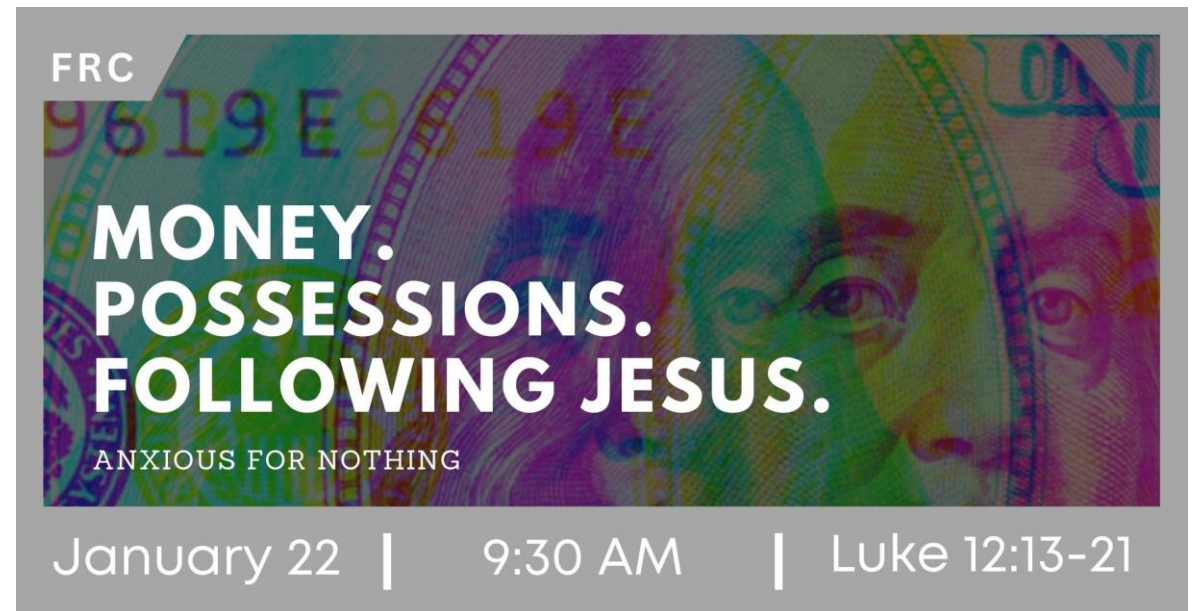
Bible Study – There will be a bible study located at Aspen Heights on Monday, January 23rd at 10am and Monday, February 13th at 10am. All are welcome to attend!
